

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01**

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BRIDGEVILLE FIRE  
PROTECTION DISTRICT  
TO APPROVE THE TAX ROLLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022  
ON REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, the Bridgeville Fire Protection District is a special district, duly formed as authorized by Fire Protection District Law of 1987 (California Health and Safety Code Section 13800); and

**WHEREAS**, the Humboldt County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) filed a Certificate of Completion of LAFCo Resolution No. 11-09 approved November 16, 2011, including the map and geographic description of the boundaries of the District, which was duly recorded by the Official Records of Humboldt County, California on September 25, 2012 as Recording 2012-023977-13; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bridgeville Fire Protection District approves the tax roll to be submitted to the Humboldt County Auditor Controller each year; and,

The special tax amount, as approved by the District voters August 28, 2012 and according to the use of the parcel, the initial special tax amount is:

- A. \$10 for unimproved parcels.
- B. \$75 for improved parcels containing one family residential dwelling.
- C. \$100 for improved parcels containing commercial structures and manufactured home parks.

**EXHIBIT A** to this resolution contains a listing of Assessor's Use Codes, Contiguous Parcel Exemption and Hardship Exemption status, the applicable tax amounts that will be used as the guide for preparing the Bridgeville FPD tax roll.

**EXHIBIT B** is the Contiguous Parcel Exemption, for parcels which are contiguous, undeveloped, held under identical ownership, and used solely for agricultural grazing, may, upon approval of an application by the owners thereof to the BFPD Board, be treated as a single parcel for purposes of this special tax.

**EXHIBIT C** is the Hardship Exemption, to allow landowners who fall within the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Guidelines for "very low"; or "poverty level" income, to apply to the Bridgeville FPD Board for a partial or complete exemption from the tax.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the board of Directors of the Bridgeville Fire Protection District adopts; the following Tax Rolls for Fiscal Year 2021/2022, which is attached hereto, and by its reference made a part hereof and; authorizes the submission to the Humboldt County Auditor Controller.




